All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

Pre-Paid Cremation Deed

Three Pre-paid Cremation Plans, Our pre-paid cremation plans are designed to provide flexibility and peace of mind. These plans can be used alongside any arrangements you may have with a Funeral Director or as a standalone option. Upon purchase, you will receive a Deed, which serves as your legally binding agreement with Bramcote Bereavement Services, a joint venture by Broxtowe & Erewash Borough Councils.

Eligibility:

- You must be aged 60 or over at the time of purchasing a plan.

Important Information:

- None of the plans include Funeral Director costs, floristry, or any additional services beyond what is specifically listed in the plan.

Below is an overview of the three plan options:

Plan 1:	Direct Cremation (Unattended) An unattended Cremation with no service and no mourners.	£530.00
Plan 2:	Direct Cremation (Attended) A 15-minute service and eulogy delivered by Bramcote Bereavement Services, Monday to Friday at 8:45am in The Reflection Chapel	£690.00
Plan 3:	Celebration Of Life Service A one-hour chapel booking with 40 minute service, Monday to Friday from 10am till 4pm in either of the two chapel. Includes full use of the music system	£1050.00
Set Up Fee:	All plans above incur a setup fee upon application	£99.00

All plans include:

- Medical Referee Fees
- Cremation, biodegradable Cremation remains box and cremation certificate collected by nominated Funeral Director or loved one.
- Scattering of ashes in Bramcote Crematorium grounds with or without family present, Monday to Friday only.
